POINT LONSDALE'S VOLUNTEER SURF LIFE SAVERS JUDGED AS SOME OF THE BEST IN VICTORIA

Volunteer Surf Life Savers from the Point Lonsdale Surf Life Saving Club have been judged as some of the most efficient, with the recent announcement of the Life Saving Victoria – Patrol Inspection Competition.

Club Captain, Mr. Dean Smith was delighted to announce that our volunteer surf life savers have demonstrated that they are amongst some of the best in the State in undertaking our number one task – to provide a safer beach and aquatic environment for the community.

"The Club was placed first in the Bellarine District Competition, which comprises Point Lonsdale, Ocean Grove, Barwon Heads / 13th Beach and Bancoora Surf Life Saving Clubs and the Geelong Life Saving Club."

"In the Bellarine District, Point Lonsdale was placed first, Barwon Heads / 13th Beach second, Ocean Grove third, Bancoora fourth and Geelong fifth."

"The Club was placed fifth in the State Competition, which is an excellent result, considering there are 57 Surf and Life Saving Clubs that are assessed against one another."

"Independent Life Saving Victoria Assessors act as Judges for the Competition and randomly check each Club three times during the Season. Patrols are checked in a range of areas, ranging from the thorough completion of log books, to rescue techniques, resuscitation proficiency, knowledge of theory components and the correct wearing of uniform".

"Local residents and visitors to the area should feel confident that their volunteer surf life savers are amongst the most qualified and most efficient in the State".

"The presentation of awards will be at the Life Saving Victoria Awards of Excellence Evening, to be held on the 18th June in Melbourne."
