



## Point Lonsdale Surf Life Saving Club Incorporated

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### HUGE NUMBERS OF PRE ENTRIES AND PREDICTED WARM WEEKEND WEATHER ARE SURE TO MAKE FOR ONE OF THE LARGEST RIP SWIMS ON RECORD

An estimated 1,500 swimmers will take part in the first of the 'three big open water swims' when the Point Lonsdale Surf Life Saving Club prepares to hold the **Stockland Rip View Swim Classic**, on **Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> December 2006**.

The **Stockland Pt Lonsdale Rip View Swim Classic** (now in its 19<sup>th</sup> year) is widely regarded as a compulsory warm up for many swimmers who take part in the Pier to Pub Swim at Lorne, to be held one week after the Point Lonsdale event, including the majority of the elite swimmers.

Pre entries are almost at 800, which is one of the largest on record. With warm weather predicted for the weekend, we may well see our field limit of 1 500 swimmer reached.

Swimmers are divided into a total of 24 categories from Juniors (12 – 16 years) to the Grandmasters (70 + years) and the first group of swimmers commence at **2:00pm**.

Event Director Mr. David Ponsford reports that, "Last year we had a fantastic number of finishers – 1 244 and I'm confident that this number will be exceeded this year". "With almost 800 already pre entered and a warm day predicted for Saturday, I hope we reach our 1 500 limit. This is a family friendly event and combined with the beautiful surrounds of Point Lonsdale the entire main street of Point Lonsdale will be turned into a carnival like atmosphere. Many thousands of spectators are predicted to view and participate in the street party atmosphere, with the main street of Point Lonsdale closed to traffic during the day, which is one of the busiest trading days for many of the Point Lonsdale traders each year."

Mr. Ponsford states that, "The swim is a major event for the Club and people should feel happy that their entry fee is helping the Club provide a voluntary service to the community, through Surf Rescue patrols at Point Lonsdale and at Queenscliff. This event is a major fundraiser for the Club and without these types of events, the Club could not continue to operate. "The Club welcomes the ongoing support of **Stockland** as major partner and thanks the many local businesses and organisations that assist with prizes, donations and other forms of assistance for this big day."

Online entries close at 6:00pm on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> December, but it is possible to enter on the day, from 10:00am (to 1:00pm or until the limit is reached) at the Front Street Point Lonsdale. On the day entries are \$ 42 which includes a high quality souvenir tee shirt, mesh bag, swim cap, certificate and refreshments.
