The Point Lonsdale Surf Life Saving Club has been working hard over the 'Winter Period' to be ready to continue to provide a service that first commenced in 1947.

We are proud to say that 'nobody has ever drowned while swimming between the flags at Point Lonsdale'. During this period, **1 406** lives have been saved by both volunteer surf life savers and professional lifeguards at the Point Lonsdale Surf Beach and the recently patrolled Santa Carsa beach at Queenscliff.

We are also excited to be moving into a recently extended and renovated Surf Rescue Base at the Point Lonsdale Surf Beach. More details about this opening will be forwarded in the near future.

I will continue in my role as the Clubs' Media Liaison Officer (Vice President – Communications) and hope to be able to keep you informed of relevant events in our area and to also act as a contact point for your enquiry's.
