



# ***New Surf Rescue Patrol Uniforms for all patrolling members for Season 2009 / 2010***

With the assistance of major partners DHL, Telstra and Westpac, Surf Life Saving Australia is supplying new patrol uniforms (shirts and shorts) to all Clubs.

The design and fabric of the new uniforms has been slightly modified to ensure all patrolling members are wearing a uniform that is both comfortable, practical and modernised, while new branding displays the logos of our major partners.

#### ***Patrol Shirt:***

- The shirt is made from 100% 'polyester micro mesh' material which is light weight, quick dry and breathable
- The material is rated SPF 45 for sun protection
- The cuffs are elasticised
- The collar can be turned up at the neck for sun protection.
- The neck and collar is non-restricting

#### ***Patrol Shorts:***

- The shorts are made from 100% 'peached polyester' material which is light weight, quick dry and breathable
- The waistband is elasticised with a drawstring
- There are pockets on both sides of the shorts

**Existing patrolling members - To get your NEW uniform, bring your current Patrol Uniform (yellow shirt and red shorts) to the Club Office (see below for opening hours) before 31st December 2009 to exchange for the NEW uniform. All Clubs have been advised that old uniforms **MUST NOT** be worn once we receive the new uniforms.**

#### **Q. What about brand new members ?**

A. Members that have not been issued a uniform in the past will be issued their uniform at Bronze Camp. (Your Camp enrolment forms have your uniform sizes listed). Cadets - at this stage, due to expected limited supplies and the limited number of patrols that you will complete after Cadet Camp, 'shared' uniforms will be utilised for Cadets when on patrol.

#### **Q. What about Bronze Camp attendees that have been issued uniforms when they were a Cadet (did their Surf Rescue Certificate) ?**

A. You must bring your shorts and shirt to be exchanged before or during the Camp to receive your new uniform.

To assist members to exchange their old yellow shirt and red shorts, for the new uniform, the Club's Office is open as follows during November:

- Each Monday, Wednesday and Friday, from 10:00am to 2:00pm.
- Saturday 28th November, from 12:00pm to 2:00pm.

#### **December Hours:**

- Monday to Fridays, from 10:00am to 2:00pm (Closed Friday 25th December - Christmas Day),
- Point Lonsdale Requalification Day (Saturday 12th December from 9:00am to 2:00pm) and
- Every other Saturday in December (Sat 5/12, Sat 19/12 and Sat 26/12) from 12:00pm to 2:00pm .
