Point Lonsdale SLSC has provided an essential community service to local residents, holiday makers and visitors since 1947. Our Club's operations help to offer a safe beach environment at Point Lonsdale and Queenscliff.

We provide lifesaving services for the community of Point Lonsdale and Queenscliff, whilst enabling our members to develop their skills, knowledge and experience in lifesaving and sports. We also aim to improve the profile and influence of the Club through community and support member involvement and leadership in development programs and initiatives.



These lifesaving services have been provided by ordinary people being prepared to assist and rescue beach visitors, often while risking their own lives to help other people they do not know. Our aim is to provide greater enjoyment for all on our beautiful beaches and in the water.

To support the long term viability of this Club, the Point Lonsdale SLSC Endowment Fund, known as "THE POINTERS", has been created. The objective of this fund is to provide a strong financial base for the ongoing development of the Club and its facilities.

BACKGROUND

In 1979 the first group of "POINTERS" was formed to begin fundraising for the Back Beach Base and the Access Track. A small, active committee met weekly and with some considerable support from members, the community and Victorian State Government, the Back Beach Base was officially opened in 1982.

FUTURE

Now, more than 30 years later, we have revitalised this successful fundraising arm of the club by forming "THE POINTERS".



Point Lonsdale Surf Life Saving Club has grown and developed considerably since 1979. We now have over 890 members, over 290 active members, over 180 associates and 27 life members. We operate beach patrols from late November to Easter Monday on weekends and public holidays with every day Boxing Day through Australia Day.

Monies received by the Point Lonsdale SLSC Endowment Fund are placed in an audited Trust Account and come from private donations, bequests and contributions from the Building Fund.

Trust monies are invested and the income from these investments assists in supporting the Club in funding for a future new clubhouse, helping establish member scholarships and also provide funding for special Club equipment.
